## PC 832 Arrest & Control Course

**2020 Dates:** Feb. 24-28 / Aug. 24-28

**Time:** 8:00am – 17:00pm (5/8 hour days)

### Pre-requisites:

1. No felony convictions. No firearms restrictions.
2. **\*Get a LIVESCAN FINGERPRINTING Clearance Letter Results can take up to 4 weeks and must be presented on first day of class in order to participate in course.**
3. Register for course with Stanislaus County Sheriff Regional Training Division Website
4. Pay fees to Stanislaus County Sheriff

*\* Students must present proof the pre-requisites were met \**

**Course:** The California Penal Code 832 -Arrest Course is the minimum introduction training standard for California limited peace officers as specified in the Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Regulation 1005 for limited peace officers powers.

*(POST) Regulation 1005 (a) (7) Every limited function peace officer shall satisfactorily meet the requirements of the PC 832 Arrest & Firearms Course, however training in the carrying and use of firearms shall not be required when an employing agency prohibits limited function peace officers the use of firearms.*

The Arrest Course is a 40-hour requirement. This course consists of 13 topics, called Learning Domains. Learning Domains contain the minimum required foundational information for given subjects. The training and testing specifications for a particular domain may also include information on required instructional activities and testing requirements.

The Arrest Course includes multiple-choice written examination and several skill examinations on Arrest and Control Techniques. The tests are graded pass/fail, with one re-test opportunity. If any re-test is failed, the course must be repeated in its entirety.

**Location: 3805 Cornucopia Way Modesto, Ca.** -The first day of this course is mandatory. Students not completing the first session will not be admitted to the class.
