THE COURSE CONTENT WILL INCLUDE LIABILITY ISSUES, MECHANICAL FUNCTIONS OF TYPICAL PATROL RIFLES, POLICY DEVELOPMENT, COURSE QUALIFICATION STANDARDS, EMPHASIS ON RIFLE DEPLOYMENT AND USE IN PATROL SETTING. MANIPULATION, MALFUNCTION, CLOSE QUARTERS SHOOTING AND RANGE CONSIDERATIONS. THIS COURSE WILL ALSO INCLUDE LONG DISTANCE MARKSMANSHIP, CONSIDERATION OF OPTICS, SUPPORT EQUIPMENT AND THE ROLE OF THE RIFLE AS IT PERTAINS TO LAW ENFORCEMENT.

1200 rounds of Rifle Ammunition
